(BG1-BG6) BOYS & GIRLS OVERNIGHT CAMP (\$480) YOUTH 7-15 YEARS OLD

For over 60 years our camp has provided a safe, fun, Christian summer camp experience. Daily activities include: swimming, boating, arts & crafts, teambuilding games, ropes course with zipline, rockwall, archery, hiking, large group team sports, and many other great adventures. Each evening the entire camp gathers for Vespers which is a time of worship, singing and Bible study. On Friday evenings we gather at a special "red carpet celebration" banquet where campers dress up for a special dinner to celebrate the week.



(LV7) LITTLE ADVENTURERS (\$120) YOUTH 5-7 YEARS OLD

(TW1-TW4) TWO WEEK CAMP (\$860)

(DSN1) DEVELOPMENTAL SPECIAL NEEDS (\$480) YOUTH 7-15 YEARS OLD

This overnight camp is for children with sensory, motor, language and social delays. Youth come to camp and experience traditional camp activities.



(DC1-DC6) DAY CAMP (\$175) YOUTH 5-15 YEARS OLD

TEEN LEADERSHIP



(TG5, TB6) TEEN CAMP (\$480) YOUTH 13-16 YEARS OLD

This week long camp teaches teens the importance of Christian friendships, while removing distractions (TV, video games, social networking) and allowing them to further unplug and build relationships face-to-face. Well trained staff with a heart for teens will mentor the campers throughout a week filled with activities to expand their faith through the exploration of themselves, each other, and God. Campers will learn how God is relative to teens of this generation. *Weeks offered by gender.*

(L12-L34) LEADERS (\$650) YOUTH 14-16 YEARS OLD

This two-week program allows teens to develop Christian leadership skills and learn the importance of teamwork through a variety of activities around camp. Activities include: trust exercises, an afternoon of our high ropes course, a canoe trip across Dan Hole Pond, a night on Sentinel's Ledges in a Yurt, plus First Aid and CPR safety training. Enrollment is limited to 16 males and 16 females.

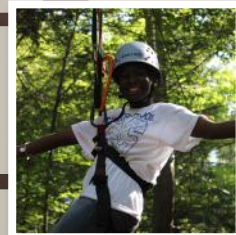
(A12-A34) ASPIRE (\$300) YOUTH 15-16 YEARS OLD

This two-week program allows teens to continue in the development of leadership skills while helping support the camp and what goes into making camp operate successfully. This program is more independent than LEADERS, and teens will be given supportive roles in housekeeping, kitchen and grounds work. Enrollment is limited to 8 males and 8 females each two-week session.

Prerequisite: (old) LIT or LEADERS

(M12-M7) MENTORS (APPLICATION) YOUTH 15-18 YEARS OLD

Campers who have completed Sentinel's LEADERS program may choose to continue on the path of aspiring to be a Sentinel staff member by serving as mentor. Mentors will learn through hands on experience with our caring well trained staff. This program is offered for 2 week and 1 week blocks- see the program calendar grid.
